Fusible Applique--EASY

REQG make a block (or more) bring to meeting, put in the drawing and you might win a group of them.

8 x 8" square	Background		Dark background	
			Brown, green, or black	
7" square	Pumpkin		Orange, yellow, pumpkin

2" scrap	Stem		Green, or brown

Applique Instructions

- Place fusible over the pumpkin pattern paper side up--and trace with a pencil or permanent marker. Shift paper a bit for the stem so there is room between it and the pumpkin for cutting.
- Cut stem fusible away, set aside
- Choose your pumpkin fabric, place fusible—glue side down—on the back side of pumpkin fabric. Press as your fusible instructions indicate. Let cool.
- Cut out pumpkin pieces using lines on the paper, (5 pcs) along the lines.
- Repeat process for stem.
- Lay your pumpkin pieces and stem right side up on the dark background in a pleasing arrangement. Leave gaps between sections. Press – let cool.
- Pin the corners of the square to the tear-away stabilizer.
- Choose a thread to enhance and stitch (narrow zigzag or blanket stitch) all around all pattern pieces.

Tip: When the needle goes down to the right, it should just fall off the edge of the applique piece. When it swings to the left it should take a bite out of the pumpkin piece.

Press –pull off stabilizer carefully—square up the block to an accurate 7 1/2" square.
