

January 2018 Block of the Month REQG
Applique – EASY, No Piecing
“First Snow Fun”

Your part: Make a block (or more) then bring it to the January meeting. Put it (them) in the drawing and you may win a group of snowmen.

Picture a bunch of these blocks in a wall hanging/small throw with red sashing encasing them.

Materials:

One 7 inch square of light blue fabric (for the background)

One 5 ½ inch square of white or off white fabric (for the snowman face) I used flannel.

One 5 ½ inch piece of paper backed fusible webbing, I used steam-a-seam

6 or 7 small black buttons and/or black snaps (for the mouth and eyes)

A small piece of orange fabric (for the nose) I'll supply this if you are at the Dec meeting.

Instructions:

Press your 5 inch white square onto the piece of fusible webbing according to the directions that come with the webbing. Cut your snowman face shape using the guide below or cut your own shape. We all know snowman heads are never precise. After all, who rolls a perfect snowball?!!!

Remove the paper back and position your snowman's head on the blue square. Press to secure. You may either hand stitch your snowman's head to the background square or machine stitch. That's your choice.

Use the same process for your snowman's nose as you did for his head.

Arrange the buttons and snaps on the snowman's face and stitch down.

Add any trimmings you choose or none at all.
